- Watt-hour rating
 - Cells (≤ 20 Wh)
 - Batteries (≤ 100 Wh)
- State of charge (SoC) $\leq 30\%$
- Net qty per package ≤ 10 kg
- Drop (1.2 m) & stack (3 m / 24 h) tests

Fully Regulated Cells & Batteries

– PI 965, Section IA –
(DG Shipping Guide #1)



- Watt-hour rating
 - Cells (> 20 Wh)
 - Batteries (> 100 Wh)
- State of charge (SoC) $\leq 30\%$
- Net qty per package ≤ 35 kg
- UN specification packaging (PG II)

The UN number(s) displayed on the mark should be at least 12 mm high.
